What **PAMIRA**[®] collects:

- ▶ Pesticide and liquid fertilizer packaging with the PAMIRA[®] trade mark
- ▶ Sorted according to plastic, metal and bags
- ▶ Containers above 50 litres must be cut through
- ▶ Flexible-volume packaging such as paper and plastic sacks, bags and boxes are also accepted.

And this is how it works:

1. Rinse!

Rinse the packaging three times by hand or with the flushing device of the agriculture sprayer. If rinsing is technically impossible, the packaging will be considered as clean if it is free of drops. Flexible packaging will be considered as clean if it is free from remnants.

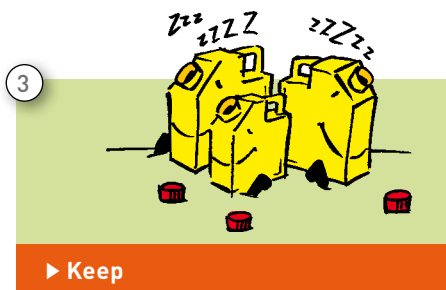
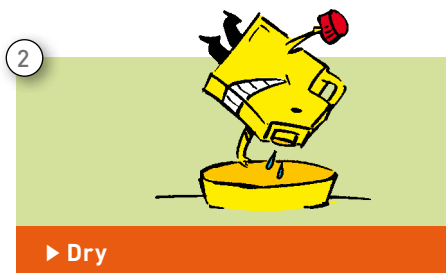
2. Leave to drip!

Add the rinsing water to the spray mixture and leave the canister to drip thoroughly above the filler of the syringe.

3. Keep!

Keep open and dry until handover.
Deliver lids separately.





When delivering the canister wear suitable clothing and protective gloves!



We check the cleanliness of the packaging during the delivery of the product remnants, unrinsed pesticide packaging and third-party packaging will be rejected.
